



Women in Institutional Investments Network Membership Policy

Women in Institutional Investments Network (WIIIN) was founded to facilitate a dialogue through education & philanthropy to advance and empower women in the Southern California institutional investment community. WIIIN strives to be inclusive of women in institutional investing across roles, functional areas of the business, and years of experience. In order to preserve the integrity of the group and keep the discussion topical and relevant for our members, we have implemented the following criteria for membership:

- Membership is open to women only. Men may be invited to attend select events as speakers or guests.
- No more than 15% of our membership may reside outside of Southern California.
- In order to keep the group both focused and manageable in size, all new members must currently hold a position in institutional investing. The primary audience WIIIN seeks to engage is women employed by plan sponsors, investment managers, and investment consultants.

Any new membership applications that do not meet the above criteria will be reviewed by the Board of Directors and approved on a case-by-case basis. Having hit the 15% threshold, we are no longer accepting individual members from outside of our Southern California community for 2018. We invite women based in other cities to join us as a guest for our events, and/or invite their firms to consider becoming corporate sponsors of WIIIN. All corporate sponsorship applications are also subject to Board approval.
