Position Description

The job will include conducting high yield and leveraged loan fixed income research on assigned companies and/or industries. This includes monitoring individual companies and related industries for financial updates, industry news or events, merger and acquisition activity and any other relevant information related to portfolio investments. Review and analyze both quantitative and qualitative data and synthesize research work-product into well-informed, thoughtful analysis and updates for investment team senior staff. This is an opportunity to work directly with senior level investment professionals on the buy side. Essential Functions:

Ensure this information is kept current at all times. Keep investment staff apprised of significant and relevant developments within assigned industries or current holdings.
- 3) Perform other job-related duties or special projects as required.
